FC:28:03 To consider and approve the Annual Accounts for the F.Y 2023-24 (Annexure - 28:03-C)

The FC noted that the Annual Accounts of the University for the F.Y 2023-24 has been prepared strictly as per the revised format of accounts, guidelines and instructions issued by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development (now MoE), Department of Higher Education vide letter N.29-4/2012.IFD dated 17th April 2015. The accounts have been prepared on accrual basis and taking into account the component of depreciation at the rates provided in the Revised Uniform Accounting Standards.

As per the Statutes under section 17(7), the Annual Accounts are required to be placed before the Finance Committee for consideration and comments and thereafter the accounts are required to be submitted to the Executive Council for approval.

The FC while discussing the agenda also noted the comments received from UGC vide Letter No. F.20-6/2018(CU)/85347 dated 23.09.2024, Central Bureau, MoE vide letter F. No. 35-6/2022-CU-I dated 25.09.2024 and IFD, MoE vide letter F. No. 9-7/2014-IFD.pt dated 26.09.2024. The clarifications raised by the members were cleared by the Finance officer and the observation made by IFD, MoE vide letter F. No. 9-7/2014-IFD.pt dated 26/09/2024 were updated and corrected. The Finance officer also clarified the reason for the delay in submission of accounts 2023-24.

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The FC considered the Annual Accounts of the University for the F.Y 2023-24 and recommended to EC for approval.

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The F.O made it clear that the University has submitted the budget estimates to UGC based on realistic assessment of funds for the University. The initial allocation received from the UGC for the FY 2024-25 under Salary (OH-36) and Capital Assets (OH-35) Head is inadequate to meet the basic requirements of the University. The committee noted that Rs. 4 crore only was allocated by UGC Under Capital Assets Head. The University authority urged UGC/MoE to consider additional grant of at least 3 crore under the head capital assets to meet the basic minimum requirements for setting up of labs, small equipments, ICT infrastructure, for the new departments and hostels made out of HEFA. Further, F.O stated that the University is somehow managing fund from its limited internal sources (IRG) and without sanction of additional funds from MoE/UGC it may be difficult to provide the basic minimum infrastructure requirements. Hence, he urged the MoE/UGC to re-consider funds under Salary and Capital Assets head as shown in the Revised Estimates. The representatives from UGC/CU Bureau, MoE suggested the University to send a realistic budget for additional allocation with justification so that the proposal can be examined and consider by the UGC/MoE through due process.

The F.O informed that the University will manage fund from internal sources and later the amount shall be recouped on receipt of additional fund from UGC in case if deficit allocation of grant under OH-36 (Salary). In this regard the members suggested to intimate the matter to UGC and MoE.

The FC while discussing the agenda also noted the comments received from UGC vide Letter No. F.20-6/2018(CU)/85347 dated 23.09.2024, Central Bureau, MoE vide letter F. No. 35-6/2022-CU-I and IFD, MoE vide letter F. No. 9-7/2014-IFD.pt.

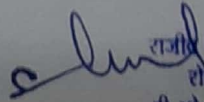
The Finance Committee perused and approved the Revised Budget Estimate for the financial year 2024-25 & Budget Estimate for the financial year 2025-26 and recommended to EC for approval.

FC:28:05 To consider increase in strength of outsourced Security personnel in RGU

The FC noted that as per EC's decision vide item No. EC-26:02 (2), wherein EC had approved engagement of 60 (sixty) nos. of Security Guards through outsourcing and accordingly University authority has engaged 40 (forty) nos. of Security Guards through outsourcing for which the financial involvement is Rs. 7, 62,000/- p.m.

The FC also noted that due to adding up of new Departments and Hostels and in view of inadequate strength of existing guards, it is proposed to engage another 20 (twenty) nos of Security Guards out of the total number approved by EC, i.e. 60 nos. for which the financial involvement will be Rs. 3,62,857/- p.m. (approx.).

After a threadbare discussion, the Finance Committee approved for engagement of another 20 (twenty) numbers of Security Guards through outsourcing taking in to account the suggestions/ comments given by UGC vide Letter No. F.20-6/2018(CU)/85347 dated 23/09/2024, Central Bureau, MoE vide letter F. No. 35-6/2022-CU-I dated 25/09/2024 and IFD, MoE vide letter F. No. 9-7/2014-IFD.pt, dated 26/09/2024.


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EC:28:06 To consider project proposal for Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) prepared by R & D Cell, RGU and submitted to HEFA, MoE, GoI.

The FC noted that the R & D Cell of RGU is proposed to set up a state-of-the-art Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) in RGU to support and foster world-class scientific research and training for R&D work in basic and applied sciences.

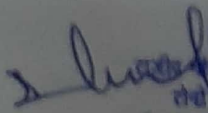
The FC also noted that a Project proposal for equipment in Central Instrumentation Facility (CIF) was submitted by Prof. Sanjeev Kumar, Dean, Faculty of Basic Sciences of Research and Development Cell, RGU for onward submission to HEFA, MoE, GoI. The Proposal for equipment in CIF submitted by R&D Cell, RGU was placed to FC for perusal.

The FC noted that as per instruction issued by IFD, MoE, only non-recurring portion of the project will be funded through HEFA. Hence, the University has been asked to exclude recurring portion from the proposal and a detailed proposal with financial implication may be sent to MoE for consideration/approval.

While discussing the agenda, Prof. Ajanta Borgohain Rajkonwar, VC, Assam Women's University and FC Member suggested the need for more funding to Universities in the north-eastern region of India, particularly when taking into account the regions rich environmental resources and the growing importance of environmental accounting. Arunachal Pradesh is endowed with rich biodiversity, forests, water bodies and mineral and these resources offer immense potential for sustainable development and for addressing climate change. Given the regions natural wealth, there is a need to develop and implement environmental accounting practices that can properly measure the value of these resources. The CUs in Northeast may be allocated more funds for development due to its geographical location/remoteness from the mainstream and would not hamper the development activities of CUs located in this region. She requested the members from UGC/MoE to consider allocation of more grants to RGU.

The Chairman also agreed with the suggestions of the member and informed the Finance Committee that there was no corpus fund in RGU at the time of his joining as Vice Chancellor, now the University has around 4 to 5 crore balance in RGU Corpus Fund. He urged more fund from UGC/MoE for procurement of equipment for CIF and maintenance of equipment of Centre for Potential for Excellence in Biodiversity (CPEB Project) sanctioned by UGC in 2003 which was adopted by RGU from its own resources despite servicing of HEFA loan. He informed that at the same time, the University shall explore the feasibility for financial Assistance/loan from HEFA as per the guidelines/norms. The F.O informed the members that University will send a detailed proposal to HEFA/MoE for financial grant under admissible components.

The FC noted that as observed by IFD, MoE and CU Bureau, MoE in the light of GFRs, 2017 and other relevant GoI/Guidelines/UGC instructions and also subject to availability of funds.

The FO informed the members that University has received proposal for software from various Departments which are very urgent for running the programmes in the Departments under Faculty of Basic Sciences.

Prof. Ajanta Borgohain Rajkonwar, F.C Member suggested that the Universities should get more funds as there is competitive benchmark for Universities with NAAC grading; the University, which has better grading, will have more funds allocated from UGC under different heads/components. Central University like Rajiv Gandhi University have started more Departments/Centres and have full-fledged UG/PG programmes, 4-year integrated UG programmes should have built-in infrastructure and the University should be provided more resources, facilities, technology, state of the art labs. The University need to put it down very seriously; otherwise the University would not be meeting the consonance of NEP 2020. She also pleaded RGU should get Energy Audit and Gender

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Budget done at the earliest.

The F.O informed the Members that the university will send a detailed proposal with justification to the MoE/UGC for consideration.

The FC while discussing the agenda also noted the comments received from UGC vide Letter No. F.20-6/2018(CU)/85347 dated 23.09.2024, Central Bureau, MoE vide letter F. No. 35-6/2022-CU-I and IFD, MoE vide letter F. No. 9-7/2014-IFD.pt. and the guidelines issued by Gol shall be adhered to.

FC:28:08 To approve financial involvement in various construction projects as recommended by the BCC in its 29th meeting held on 19th June 2024.

The Minutes of 29th BCC held on 19th June 2024 was placed before the FC.

The FC after detailed discussion approved the financial estimates of various construction projects as recommended by the BCC in its 29th meeting held on 19.06.2024. As suggested by UGC/MoE, the University should segregate its minor/major construction projects funded by HEFA, UGC Campus Development Fund, Recurring grant, State Government and internal sources and send detailed proposal with justification to HEFA/MoE/UGC for consideration.

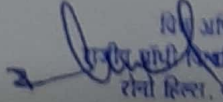
The Minutes of the 30th meeting of BCC held on 23rd September 2024 was also placed to F.C as table agenda. During the meeting, the representatives of JS & FA, IFD, MoE informed that the minutes of 30th BCC should have been circulated in advance to all the concerned members and discourage table agenda. However, the Chairman clarified the need for placing the minutes of 30th BCC to FC. The FC after deliberation approved the minutes of 30th BCC in principle and suggested to share the minutes of 30th BCC to all the FC Members for obtaining comments.

FC:28:09 To decide on release of CPF subscription in r/o Prof. Bhagabat Nayak (Retd).

The FC noted that Prof. Bhagabat Nayak joined as Associate Professor, Departemnt of English, Rajiv Gandhi University on 07.07.2014. During the time of his joining, provision for subscription in CPF was not applicable for him due to implementaon of NPS. Prior to joining as Associate Professor in RGU, Prof. Bhagabat Nayak was working as Lecturer at Kujang College, Jagatsinghpur, Orissa having pension scheme. Upon joining at RGU, he has requested for subscription in GPF-cum-Pension as he was previously working in pensionable establishment. However, he was allowed to subscribe in CPF subject to switch over to NPS in due course of time as the matter related to GPF/Old pension scheme was under consideration with Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and Union Ministries, Govt. of India. However, he continued to subscribe in CPF till his retirement without switching to NPS.

Now, he is seeking withdrawal of his final CPF subscription (self + employer's share). Due to non-subscription/switch over to NPS, he will not be in a position to earn the benefit of additional 4 % share from employer as per NPS.


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The FC discussed and resolved that Prof. Bhagabat Nayak (Retd.) may be allowed to withdraw his final CPF subscription (self + employer's share) from the University.

FC:28:10 Item for Ratification:

a) Out sourcing of Hostel staff for 4 nos of HEFA funded Hostels in RGU

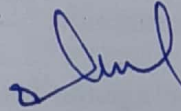
The construction work of 4 nos. of HEFA funded Hostels have already completed and accordingly students were allotted accommodation in those hostels. Hence there was an urgent need for appointment of hostel staff, which has been outsourced. In this regard, the university administration has outsourced the required hostel staff.

The FC ratified the action taken by the University authority.

b) To ratify the action taken by the University on the proposal of Fee Structure of BA 4-Year (Hons) and MBA, submitted by Director, Institute of Distance Education, RGU.

The proposed Fee structure submitted by Director, IDE for BA and MBA courses which is placed as **Annexure - 28:10-G** has been approved by the University for implementation.

The FC ratified the action taken by the University authority.



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FC:28:11 Reporting Item:

- a) In pursuance of the UGC Letter No. 67-3/2021 (CU) dated 19th July 2023 and Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Government of India O.M No. 4-21/2017-IC/E.IIIA dated 04.07.2023 the University has re-fixed the pay of eligible employees of RGU as per the condition enumerated in para 7 of the same O.M. dated 28.11.2019 in their respective pay levels vide order NO. PF-Estt.340/AI/2024 dated 04.06.2024.

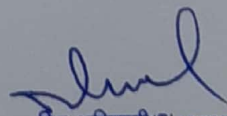
