- iii. Exemption from skill test (For PwD)
- iv. The reservations/relaxations to SC/ST/OBC/PWD/EWS candidates will be provided as per the existing Govt. of India/UGC rules.

In admission, the following concessions has been given to reservation category candidates (SC/ST/OBC/PwD/EWS) as per the GoI guidelines and University Ordinances and Orders:

- i. Concession in the minimum eligibility marks
- ii. Relaxation in upper age limit to all
- iii. Concession of Application Fee (For SC/ST/Pwd)
- iv. Bonafide students from affiliated colleges of Rajiv Gandhi University belonging to all categories (majority of whom are ST students) shall be given an additional weightage of 10% over and above their RGUCET/CUET score (whichever is applicable) for preparing the merit list for admission in various Post Graduate and Under-graduate courses including B.Ed. & B.PEd. Likewise, the APST (Arunachal Pradesh Scheduled Tribe) applicants passing out from other UGC recognised universities shall be given an additional weightage of 5% over and above their RGUCET/CUET score.
