


Guidelines for Promotion and Academic Progression for UG and PG Programmes under NEP 2020

- 1. A candidate will be promoted to the next semester provided:
 - (a) Passes at least 50% of the Major and Minor Papers taken together, and
 - (b) Earned a minimum of 45% of the total credits required for the semester.
- 2. Absent and Failure in a Course (Paper) or in a Component (Theory/Practical):
 - (a) A student shall be deemed eligible to appear in the examination upon satisfying the minimum attendance and internal assessment requirements, and have submitted the Examination Form.
 - (b) An eligible student absent from the examination of a specific course or component shall be deemed to have failed that course or component only.
 - (c) A student who failed a component (theory/practical) of a course is required to reappear only for that component of the course in the subsequent examination.
 - (d) Such students shall be eligible for promotion to the next semester, subject to the fulfillment of all other requirements specified in clause (1).
- 3. A student who fails in any semester, including the first semester, is not required to readmit in the same semester. Such students shall be treated as year-back students.
- 4. The year-back students will have to submit their willingness to continue the programme by submitting a willingness form with a deposit of the continuation fee.
- 5. The year-back students shall not be permitted to attend the regular classes.
- 6. Such students will retain the credits they have already earned in the semester (in which they have failed) and will have to appear only in those courses (papers) which they could not clear in their earlier attempt(s).
- 7. The student must appear for the failed course(s) in the regular examination conducted in the corresponding semester of the following academic year:
- 8. If the student meets the promotion criteria as specified in Clause (1), he/she shall be promoted to the next semester and continue the programme with the next/subsequent batch.

- 9. Undergraduate students who exit the programme shall be permitted to re-enter within a maximum interval of three (03) years between any two semesters.
- 10. A student must complete all the courses of the programme he/she has enrolled within the specified time frame as follows:
 - (a) Three-Year /Four-Year Undergraduate Programme: within seven (07) years
 - (b) Two-Year Post-Graduate Programme: within five (05) years
 - (c) One-Year Post Graduate Programme: within three (03) years
- 11. Students shall be permitted to take any number of attempts to pass a course (paper), provided such attempts are made within the stipulated timeframe specified in Clause 10.
