Dear Ma'am/Sir,

Please refer to the joint DO letter dated 6.8.2024 of Secretary, MoSJE and Secretary, DoHE (enclosed) outlining awareness activities and institutional mechanism in HEIs covering all students in the campus (day scholars and hostellers) as part of Nasha Mukht Bharat Abhiyan (NMBA).

2. The list of awareness activities included nukkad natak, skits and plays, yoga, meditation, sports and physical activities including leveraging influential alumni from the colleges for the NMBA. It also sought to institutionalize NMBA covering the whole academic cycle of a student starting from anti-drug declaration and a seminar on awareness against substance abuse for the fresh batch as part of their orientation and culminating with a valedictory session showcasing achievements and motivating students to lead a drug free life. It also envisaged formation of an anti-drug committee, constitution of clubs aimed at drug free campus, provision of individual and group counselling and formation of Nasha Mukht Hostel Committees for continuous engagement with hostellers.

3. The progress on creating awareness about NMBA on the campuses also came up for review in the 8th APEX Level NCORD meeting held on 15.5.2025 under the chairmanship of Union Home Secretary. It was decided that in addition to the ongoing activities as part of NMBA on the campus, the following initiatives may also be carried out :-

- i. Increased focus on the institutions based on proximity to international border, pressure environments (like IITs/IIMs) and known hotspots
- ii. Need for holistic student development beyond academics and engaging youths in extracurricular activities like yoga, sports etc.
- iii. Dining halls to be professionally managed with supply of wholesome food and those skipping on meals should be monitored for likely substance abuse or any other problem
- iv. CCTVs should be installed in the perimeter wall and entrances to the campus to check on entry of drug couriers and suppliers
- v. Holding of week-long awareness / de-addiction camp in the Universities / Institution every 6 months with an objective of Drug Free Campuses
- vi. Designate the Registrar or equivalent officer as Anti-Drug Officer in each institution.

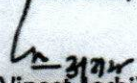

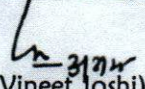
